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# **KEY WEST, FLORIDA**

Key West, a U.S. island city, is part of the Florida Keys archipelago. It's also Florida's southernmost point, lying roughly 90 miles north of Cuba. Famed for its pastel-hued, conch-style houses, it's a cruise-ship stop also accessible from the mainland via the Overseas Highway. It's known more for its coral reefs – destinations for diving and snorkeling – than for its beaches, according to Google.

### DAY ONE

Arrive in Key West

Take the shuttle down the 7-mile bridge and check into the hotel

Dinner: Bagatelle (\$\$, Seafood) and sit outside for people watching

Drinks: any place in Mallory Square, then find a spot to applaud the sunset and see the fabled green flash said to occur the moment the sun sinks below the watery horizon

#### **DAY TWO**

9 AM Breakfast: <u>Cuban Coffee Queen</u> (\$, American & Coffee), and get a picture of the famous crossing arrows

10 AM – Start your day exploring Mallory Square, which is the center of attention

- If you're up for it, here is a self-guided tour (<u>PDF</u>) of Key West; time spent is 1-2 hours 11:30 AM <u>Mel Fisher Maritime Museum</u> (time spent 1.5 hours, \$15 USD) for famous pirates, shipwrecks and treasures; lab tours also available
  - Or the other pirate museum is Key West Shipwreck Museum (\$16 USD)

Lunch: local favorite, Sloppy Joe's Bar (\$\$, Burgers & Bar)

Get a pineapple drink at <u>The Smallest Bar in the World</u>, inside of the Smallest Bar Inn, on Dunval Street Save room for some dessert, with a slice of key lime pie at <u>Key Lime Pie Bakery</u> (\$, Bakery)

2 PM – Shop the small marketing and mini-malls, The Key West Sponge Market

3 PM – visit the <u>Custom House Museum</u> with sculptures outside and galleries inside

- Stay outside and snap some pics with the art, you don't need to tour
- 4:45 PM Close encounters with the <u>Key West Aquarium</u> (time spent is 1.5 hours, \$16 USD) or visit the <u>Truman Little White House</u> (\$20 USD)

6:30 PM – then venture up to <u>Key West Historic Memorial Sculpture Garden</u>, a free courtyard where you'll find 36 busts of influential Key West people

• Sunsets are a big deal, join the party at Mallory Square overlooking the water and sunset key in the distance.

Dinner: <u>Fogarty's</u> (\$\$, American) or <u>Caroline's Café</u> (\$, American) – and you must get the conch fritters Bar: <u>Irish Keven's Bar</u> (\$\$, Irish Pub) with lively Irish music and dancing

## **DAY THREE**

Grab a coffee and a light breakfast

10 AM – Have some fun with <u>Fury Key West</u>, Ultimate Adventure (time spent is 6 hours, \$140 USD) for parasailing, jet-skiing, mini water park and reef snorkeling on the third largest reed in the world in the Gulf of Mexico

- Breakfast and lunch provided
- Bring a bag (water-proof preferred) to store your items, also some extra snacks and water bottles
- Check the page for a list of 'What to Bring'

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• Or Barefoot Billy's Jet Ski Island Tour; 1.5 hours

4:30 PM – Back to the hotel to clean up and eat some snacks

6:30 PM - Sail with Danger Charters for a Wind & Wine Sunset Sail; time spent is 2 hours, \$85 USD

- Choose from 8 different wines from around the world and choose from 5 domestic and imported beers
- Heavy hors 'devours are served

If you're hungry, hurry over to <u>Gabro's Grill</u> (\$, Tacos & Burgers) for some tacos before they close Drinks at <u>Capt. Tony's Saloon</u> (\$, Famous Bar – visited by Hemingway, Buffet and more) Then <u>Hog's Breath Saloon</u> (\$\$, Pub)

• Finally, <u>Bull Bar</u> for a visit to Garden of Eden's clothing optional bar – fair warning, you cannot unsee what you see (\$\$, Lounge)

### **DAY FOUR**

Lazy morning: coffee at the local shop and lounge

11 AM – Come hungry and wear comfy shoes for a food tour by <u>Key West Food Tours</u>, Southernmost Food Tour; time spent 3 hours, \$75 USD

2:30 PM - Check out touristy spots and landmarks

- 1. Start at the Mile Marker 0 on Whitehead Street and Fleming Street
- 2. This is a 20-minute walk or 5-minute ride, your choice.
  - a. If you want to ride, walk down a block to Pirate Scooter Rentals
- 3. Grab a drink at Green Parrot Bar (\$\$, Bar)
- 4. Stroll the <u>Ernest Hemingway Home and Garden</u> (time spent is 1 hour, \$14 USD) which is now home to over 40 cats, most with 6 toes
  - a. If you need a snack, pop into Nine One Five (\$\$\$, Tapas) for a bowl of Chipotle Conch Chowder
- 5. Gaze upon the Key West Lighthouse (time spent is 30 min, \$10 USD) take a picture and move
- 6. Rest at the Key West Butterfly and Nature Conservatory; time spent is 1 hour, \$12 USD)
- 7. Finish at the Southernmost Point Buoy (in the Continental USA)

Rest up at the hotel

7 PM Dinner: Antonia's Restaurant (\$\$\$, Italian), has amazing calamari and seafood

Drink: Virgilio's (\$\$, Bar) a fancy martini bar

9:30 PM - Encounter the other side with a Ghost & Gravestones tour; time spent is 1.5 hours, \$34 USD

Wear comfortable shoes

### **DAY FIVE**

Quick breakfast or Cuban Coffee Queen again

9 AM – Fun in the sun on the beaches, 4 options below:

- Higgs Beach (man-made with white sand imported from the Caribbean)
  - Setup on Higgs Beach and enjoy, things to do: walk down the Edward B. Knight Pier aka White Street Pier, visit the historical landmark West Martello Tower, or put a pup at the Dog Park
  - o lunch at <u>SALUTE!</u> on the beach (\$\$, Mediterranean), then continue your day in the sun
- Smathers Beach (man-made with white sand imported from the Caribbean) using this one
- Fort Zachary Taylor Historic State Park (\$2 per person, natural beach and slightly rockier)
- Purchase a day pass from Margaritaville Key West Resort for Sunset Key Beach, \$40 USD

Setup on Smathers Beach, it has it all. Sunset Watersports Key West offers chairs, umbrellas, rafts and more starting at \$10 – relax

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Bring water and snacks with you

2 PM - back to the hotel to clean up

4 PM – Afternoon rum tasting at <u>Key West First Legal Rum Distillery</u>; time spent 1.5 hours, free tour 6:30 PM - Stumble over to for dinner at <u>The Commodore's Boathouse Bar & Grill</u> (\$\$, Bar & Grill)

Stay here to watch the sunset and have drinks (try a passion fruit mojito)

Dessert: Kermit's Key West Key Lime Shoppe (\$\$, Bakery) for a frozen chocolate covered key lime pie slice

## **DAY SIX**

10 AM Brunch: Blue Heaven (\$\$, American) and order key lime pie slice for dessert

• Embrace the local chickens run around like they own the joint

1 PM - Explore underwater gardens by snuba-ing with <u>Key West Snuba Diving</u>; time spent is 3 hours, \$109 USD

You do not need a diving certification

4:30 PM – back to the hotel to get ready for a fancy evening out

7 PM Dinner: Mangoes Restaurant (\$\$\$, New American)

9 PM - prepare for a show at Aqua Key West (\$\$\$, Drag Show) and stay for dancing

#### DAY SEVEN

10 AM Breakfast: <u>Camille's Restaurant</u> (\$\$, American) and savor the Godiva White Chocolate French Toast

Spend the rest of the day at Ocean Key Resort & Spa, <u>Spa Terre</u> and get a day pass to the resort, enjoying the private beach

- Or ride a beach cruiser, rented from <u>BikeMan Bike Rental Key West</u>, Cruiser Bikes; \$10 USD for the day, and explore areas that you may have passed up earlier, or revisit some favorites
- Or go back to a beach, see Day 5

Dinner: <u>Bliss Restaurant Key West</u> (\$\$, Seafood), sip on red or white sangria or keep it easy with <u>Duetto Pizza and Gelato</u> (\$\$, Pizza)

Return to Mallory Square for a final night of entertainment

#### **DAY EIGHT**

10 AM Breakfast: <u>Two Friends Patio Restaurant</u> (\$\$, American)

Clean up and check out of the hotel Goodbye Key West. Head home.
